## CEO Report on Facilities, Maintenance and Administration

<u>Grounds and Equipment:</u> Focusing on event prep and clean up. Horse show was a big focus in getting the gates and facilities in the arena up and working properly. We continue to worry about the aging wooden bucking chutes. Many boards were replaced again this year. We have a septic problem at the golf course property. With the use by CHP last weekend the system overflowed onto the lower patio. We need to do some research on the exact problem and get advice on solutions. Our water continues to be tested regularly and we have not had any negative tests this year.

<u>Rentals:</u> The Horse show used the whole property the last two weekends of June and the Pinnacle room for the Queen contest before that. Report of the June rentals is included.

<u>Camping:</u> We have 6 campers here finishing a construction project. They have agreed to move to other parts of the facility with limited amenities during large events in order to stay for the duration of their jobs. Other camping events include the Saddle Horse Show, Camp 47Ride camping, All Girls Roping and CGA Camping. Monthly numbers are included on the rentals report.

<u>Heritage Foundation</u>: Dara attended the June Meeting and shared the draft of the most recent financials. Since they weren't approved by the board, I marked them draft. We are still working to get a roofing contractor for the leaking roofs. They asked about progress on the Golf Course conversations and I did not have a report from the committee on our side.

<u>Administrative and Office</u>: June was rough in the office. Horse Show has GREAT people working in the office but it is loud and busy. Another opportunity has come up that I will be able to give you more information on soon.
